The annual WCWS Members Exhibition will be held September 4 - September 25, 2026 at the Art Center of Western Colorado, 1803 N. 7th Street, Grand Junction, CO 81501.

All members are encouraged to enter original water media paintings in this non-juried show!

All paintings must be walked in and priced for sale.

Delivery of paintings is Tuesday September 1st, from 10am to 11am at the Art Center.

The hanging of the show will begin that day.

Entry fee: 1 or 2 paintings \$12.00 each

3 paintings \$30.00

BIN WORK: (no entry fee) maximum 3 pieces, each piece priced \$100 or less.

Make checks payable to WCWS.

All paintings are to be hand delivered to the Art Center. Place a label on the upper left back with title, artist, and price. Place an additional label on the front of the work showing the title only. This label is for judging purposes.

All work must be picked up on Saturday September 26 from 10am to 12pm.

Paintings are to be in watermedia painted in the watercolor method on watercolor paper, Yupo or watercolor canvas. Work must be done in the last three years and not shown before in any WCWS exhibit or at the Art Center. Work must be original.

Paintings must be framed and matted under glass or plexiglass. Work must be wired and ready to hang. No sawtooth hangers.

Sales of paintings include a 20% commission to the Art Center and 10% commission to WCWS. Price your paintings to reflect this. Payment for sold work will be sent to the artist.
