ENTRY PROCEDURE

On-line or email entries only. **CD entries will not be accepted.** Only the image of the painting should be shown on entries – no frames or background.

FILE FORMAT: JPEG, highest quality, 1200 pixels longest side (short side will adjust automatically) at 300 dpi, **Label files:** 1) Last name_first name_title 2) Last name_first name_title (Example: 1 Doe_John_Grand Painting.) may be lower case.

ON-LINE ENTRIES: To register & pay online, go to www.wcwsociety.org and click on Rockies West National 2020 to view prospectus. Follow instructions to enter all information and attach images. Follow instructions to pay by your PayPal account or credit card. By entering online, you agree to abide by all show rules and requirements

EMAIL ENTRIES: Send email with image/s as attachment/s. Follow file format above. In the body of the email, include the following information matching name and title to the attached image/s:

SHIPPING AND RETURN OF WORK

Detailed instructions will be sent by E-mail with notice of selection. All selected artwork should be shipped in **sturdy and reusable** carton with at least 2" of foam on all sides of the painting (**No "popcorn" packaging**). The Art Center will accept paintings shipped prepaid via UPS or FedEx Ground, February 10th thru 21st. There will be a non-refundable **\$20.00 handling fee**. Unsold paintings will be shipped by April 7 (**prepaid by the artist**) and sent by the same carrier as received, unless otherwise noted. Hand delivered art will be accepted Monday March 2, 9 to 11 a.m.. Pick up will be Monday Mar. 30, 1 to 3 p.m.

ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS

The Exhibition is open to any artist 18 years of age or older. **The paintings are limited to water media with the appearance of watercolor on paper**, No shiny varnished work. Yupo or un-stretched watercolor canvas (to be matted and framed under Plexiglas). All collage material must be paper painted by the artist. Paintings must be original work, completed within the last three (3) years and signed by the artist. **PAINTINGS MUST MATCH THE JURIED IMAGE OR WILL BE RETURNED WITHOUT BEING EXHIBITED OR JUDGED FOR AWARDS.** Artists who fail to send the accepted painting will be denied consideration in the next two (2) ROCKIES WEST National Exhibits. No computer generated work. No work previously accepted by WCWS or that has been exhibited at the Art Center.

Min. Framed Size: 16" x 20" (36" total united inches).
Max. Framed Size: Not to exceed 50" in either direction.

Framing requirements: All work must be **matted and framed** in a professional manner, under **PLEXIGLAS**. Glass on hand delivered work will be accepted on frame sizes 24"x30" and under. Work must be framed with strong wire tightly secured and ready to hang. (No sawtooth hangers) **Mats must be white or light neutral color, 1/4" colored liner permitted.** Any works that don't meet these standards of excellence will not be exhibited.

TO BECOME A MEMBER

MASTER SIGNATURE MEMBERSHIPS are awarded for ten (10) acceptances with no time limit applied. In order to qualify, the artist must become a member and keep their dues current, the same as for Signature membership

Several awards have led to Signature status in the National Watercolor Society, Missouri Watercolor Society and Transparent Watercolor Society along with being a Master Signature member with the Illinois Watercolor Society.

Artist Statement

Starting in art school and all thru my early years as an illustrator I was encouraged to paint in many different mediums and styles. I tried them all but, in the end, I settled on watercolor. The spontaneity and flow just fit my personality. One of the things asked of the artists is to define what inspires them to do what they do. The one thing that comes to mind before anything else is the play of sunlight which defines and creates a mood.
